
Bien plus qu'un monument

Practical information for exploring the castle





Built in the 12th century, Haut-Kænigsbourg castle has witnessed nine centuries of European conflicts and rivalries between lords, kings and emperors. It has had a succession of illustrious owners, including the Habsburg dynasty and Wilhelm II, the last German Emperor.

In the early 20th century he ordered the spectacular restoration of this mountain fortress.

Today, Haut-Kœnigsbourg gives a remarkable picture of life in a 15th century fortress in Alsace.

It houses a large collection of weapons and furnishings from the 15^{th} , 16^{th} and 17^{th} centuries and provides an original illustration of life in the Middle Ages.

Constructed at an altitude of nearly 800 metres, this exceptional monument has a magnificent view over the plain of Alsace, the Vosges, the Black Forest and, on a clear day, the Alps.

Open all year round

The castle is open all year round, every day except the 1st January, 1st May and 25th December.

Ticket office opening hours

January, February, Nov, Dec.	9:30 to 12:00 and 13:00 to 16:30
March, October	9:30 to 17:00
April, May, Sept.	9:15 to 17:15
June, July, August	9:15 to 18:00

The castle closes in the evening 45 minutes after the ticket office.


